	members. Explained current Project with line extension to
	Masontown. Paige explained that PSD#1 is having issue with
	one employee from construction company doing line
	extension. Scott flipped out on PSD#1 employees because we
	didn't know they were going to be in that location. Eric stated
	that we didn't know they were working and that they busted
	our line causing and outage. Rodney was concerned that they
	are not communicating with PSD#1 about work plans.
	Because we need to communicate with our customers. They
	work for PSD#1 we do not work for them so we should always
	be told what plans are. Cullin stated that he would speak to
	the supervisor. Rodney requested Scott be removed from the
	project because they need to be respectful and
	communicate. Tina stated that Blue Ridge Fibers is constantly
	behind on their bills. Rodney advised to send a letter of intent
	to charge Security Deposit to the company. Cullin stated that
	quote to go under the pond is astronomical, well over

\$200.000. But we are unable to afford that with this project.

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So if we don't get a better price then we may need to do it as a normal trench after the pond is drained. Still in discussing and working through it. Masontown is locked into buying water from us for 40 years and has been agreed to by the PSC. Birdscreek – DEP is offering to fund water line extension for upgrade.

Robbie- Explained project funding to new board members And the rates do not have to be raised on the customer. Requested \$243.827.30 to pay Thrasher and contractor. Rodney and Tina signed checks for Robbie.

Public Relation: Introduction of new board members Justin lcard (Treasurer) and John Bishoff (Secretary)

Rodney stated that Samantha Stone contacted him with a complaint from a customer about poor quality water. It did not go into detail because customer did not show up. The customer stated that she has not had good water in 10 years. Customer is rude. The customer called the PSC as well. Tina - She had originally called here and she wanted her bill adjusted off because of lines being fix and she didn't have service on 2 separate days. Advised her that would not be possible. Them she stated that the water Quality was so bad she could not even shower. When I attempted to transfer call to Eric, she hung up on me. Then she called the PSC and wrote an email to County Commission. Tina stated that we received a call from PSC (Vickie). Eric stated that he went to the house and tested water and it was fine. Eric sent results to customer. He advised customers husband that if they had to flush we would adjust any extra usage. There was no extra usage to be adjusted. Eric called Vickie back at PSC and explained what went on.
