

Important Information About Your Drinking Water

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for

Preston County PSD1, WV3303912

Our water system violated drinking water monitoring requirements. Even though this is not an emergency, you, as our customers have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards or not. During period listed in the table below, we did not achieve the required monitoring.

What Should I Do?

At this time, no alternative source of water is necessary.

The table below lists the monitoring required, how often we are supposed to sample and, when the samples should have been taken.

| Required Monitoring | Required Monitoring Frequency | Compliance Period |
|---|-------------------------------|-------------------|
| Monitoring, Routine (DBP), MAJOR failure to report Required chlorine residual with a coliform sample result | monthly | 6/1/25 to 6/30/25 |
| WB, Chlorine Chlorine missing from coliform result | monthly | 6/1/25 to 6/30/25 |
